## Geauga Radio Controlaires Fly RC Planes Year-Round in Geauga County

The Cleveland Radio Controlaires, Inc., Chapter #497 of the Academy of Model Aeronautics, d.b.a. **Geauga Radio Controlaires**, is a 67 year-old RC flying club of 90 members of all ages. We've been flying RC planes year-round for 44 years in Geauga County, Ohio and now fly at TWO of the largest RC flying sites in the region – one with an E-W grass runway and one with both an E-W and a N-S grass runway. Most of our members fly piston engine planes, but we do have a growing number of members flying electric planes of all sizes, and a few fly quad-copters, and helicopters.



Our members fly at locally owned **flying sites** located in Burton and Middlefield Townships. You will find our club members **flying** on Mondays from 10AM-2PM, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10AM to 9PM, Sundays from 1PM-8PM. We fly on Wednesdays from 10AM-9PM only at the Middlefield flying site.

Our **club meetings** are held the **first Thursday of every month** at 7:00PM at the Mangia Mangia Italian Restaurant located at 11081 Kinsman Road in Newbury, OH 44065. For a decade we have hosted one of the largest **RC Swap Meets** in the region as our annual fund raiser for RC flying education.

## FREE Lessons for first time Flyers

Our **Introductory Pilot Program** enables first-time flyers to take a test flight with one of our Instructors, but we prefer that you first practice on a **flight simulator**. This tends to make for a longer and more enjoyable first flying



experience. We recommend trying and buying the RealFlight flight simulator. It's available at local model airplane retailers like Hobby Town in Mentor, TOY-N-HOBBY Headquarters in Madison, Aero-Tech Hobbies in North Canton, and Hobby Hangar in Medina. The **Federal Aviation Administration** (FAA) requires that you register as a *Recreational Flyer* with at <a href="https://faadronezone.faa.gov">https://faadronezone.faa.gov</a> <a href="https://before.gov">before</a> making your first SOLO flight anywhere. The cost is just \$5 for a 3-year registration. Visit <a href="https://knowbeforeyoufly.org/">https://knowbeforeyoufly.org/</a> for more information.

To fly regularly, you will need to join the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) to obtain liability insurance. You will



find that AMA membership is required by all RC Flying clubs in the USA. AMA membership is \$85/year for adults under 65, \$75/year for those over 65, and \$15/year for youth under the age of 19. Join the AMA or learn more about the benefits of AMA membership at www.modelaircraft.org. If you are already a member of the AMA, you can fly as a sponsored Guest at our field with one of our members present (restrictions apply). **To apply for membership**, visit our website to get an application, and bring it to one of our monthly meetings. A one-time \$100

Initiation Fee and Annual dues are payable when you become a member. Regular membership is \$70/year and Senior membership is \$45/year. Junior membership is just \$10/year with no initiation fee.
